Admission requirements

HAVO, VWO, MBO (level 4) or an equivalent school-leaving certificate along with passing the audition selection and medical test. Israeli applicants should have passed the 'Teudat Bagrut' = matriculation exams.

Admission Requirements - English Proficiency

Since the programme is taught in English, command of this language is essential. Communicative skills in English are considered the most important within the programme. The requirements are: IELTS with a minimum score of 5.5 (overall band score).

Tuition Fees Foreign Students

The legally stipulated tuition fees for the 2019-2020 academic year is:

- EU or EER citizens - €2.083,- per study year
- Non EU or EER citizens - €7.500,- per study year
