ArtEZ Master's course Music Therapy Study plan | Full-Time Modality

Dear prospective student,

Thank you for your interest in enrolling to the 1 year, full-time modality of the master's course Music Therapy at ArtEZ. The course takes place on campus, with class dates on Thursdays and Fridays, including some shared classes with the Part-time cohort in a hybrid modality. Additionally, take into account that for completing the required 280 clinical hours, you will need at least one full day for a supervised internship or work experience, and one additional full day for studying, on top of conducting your culminating project. To be admitted to the full-time modality, you will have to be located and complete your supervised internship or work experience, **in or near the Netherlands**.

Furthermore, in order to be able to achieve the Master competencies in this comprised period, you will need to provide through this study plan a clear plan on your ideas for music, and music therapeutic development, as well as for your culminating project. *Please note that the full-time programme will only take place if a minimum of four students are eligible for this intense modality.*

The admission procedure entails:

- Meeting the admission criteria (see website)
- The completion of the present study plan,
- a video recording of a musical performance (see description below),
- and an admission interview with the coordinator and the head of programme.

Full time Study plan - Please answer the questions below:

- 1. How would you define your **identity as a music therapist?** For this, take the identity profiles described by ArtEZ (Innovator, Adaptive Expert, Community Builder) into account.
- 2. Which ideas do you have to advance your musical skills during your studies?
- 3. Which ideas do you have to advance your **Music Therapy knowledge and skills** (e.g. target population and specific music therapy approach(es)?
- 4. Supervised Internship and Work experience. During the master's course you will complete 280 hours of supervised internship, if you are enrolling with a complete pre-master's course; or clinical work experience, if you are already a certified music therapist. It is mandatory for the student to arrange an internship place and inform us, before the month of June. To complete 280 hours, you will need to work at least one full day per week throughout one year. Accredited music therapists will present proof of their work place and hours to inform these hours.

Indicate below where you will complete these hours (city and name of the institution) and, if possible, the name of the music therapist at the institution (for internship only).

5. Culminating project. Throughout your studies you will work on your final graduation project, your culminating project. At the end of the academic year, you will present it through a written article, a private defence, and a public symposium. You can choose different ways to conduct your final project, for instance: a community music therapy project, a feasibility clinical study, a literature review, a survey, a music based research, etc. depending on the final goal of your project. You will be guided by a specialized coach throughout the entire process. To be admissible to the full-time modality of the programme, you will need to write your ideas for this culminating project as detailed as possible.

- 6. Send us a **video recording of a musical performance** to show us your musicality (3-5 minutes). There are no detailed requirements; it can be a home of professional recording, playing your main musical instrument, singing, or whatever feels joyful to you. We wish to see your musical self!
- 7. Tell us about your motivation for pursuing this intense 1-year full time modality?
- 8. Show us how you are planning to complete all the tasks throughout one year. How will your week planning and your year planning look like? (Consider following the courses, study and writing time, clinical internship or work experience, preparing, conducting, and writing about your culminating project)
